The Children & Family Resource Center (CFRC) is a 501c3 non-profit organization located in Henderson County, NC. CFRC was created in November, 1998 as a result of a Children's Initiative of the Community Foundation of Henderson County which addressed the barriers that were preventing or impeding families from accessing local services. Today, CFRC offers programs that address the various aspects of early childhood development and education, quality child care, parenting and family support. In addition to our programs, CFRC also serves as a referral center for clients who are in need of services in our community. We house a comprehensive early learning resource library for parents and care providers of young children.

FROM THE DIRECTOR

One of our amazing volunteers shared a quote with us recently by R.L. Stevenson, that sums up the work we do at Children & Family Resource Center. Stevenson wrote, "Don't judge each day by the harvest you reap but by the seeds that you plant."

Every day we work with child care providers and support them as they plant the seeds for children's future learning and development. We work with first time parents, experienced parents, foster parents, and grandparents and help them create safe and nurturing environments for their children to grow and develop and learn what it means to have a caring adult in their life. We screen three and four-year-olds for developmental delays so they can thrive in kindergarten on day 1, ready to learn.

We couldn't do this work without the seeds that you have planted as well as donors, community partners, and volunteers. The seeds we plant today have a positive long-term effect on the life of the children, the caregivers, and the systems in our community that serve them.

Research shows that secure attachments formed in the first 5 years of life can significantly impact the lifelong development of the child. A secure attachment pattern will be a protective factor for the child throughout the lifespan.

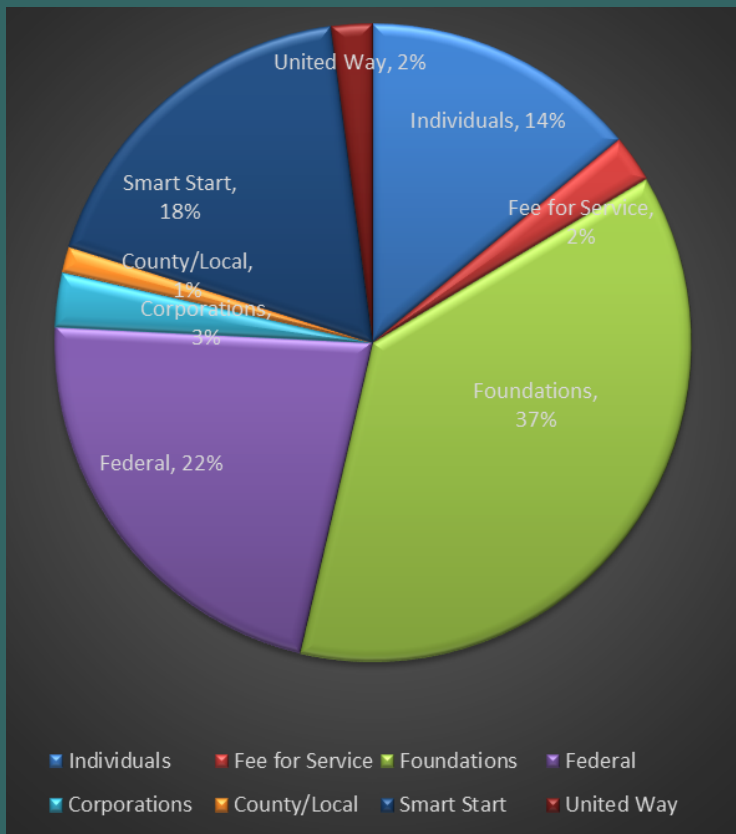

2021-2022 PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS

EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION PROGRAMS:

Early Childhood Workforce Development - trained 17 participants in 3 cohorts and enrolled 13 substitutes in EDU119. By the end of the grant year, 8 participants were offered employment at child care centers in Henderson and Transylvania counties.

Preschoolers Reaching Educational Potential (PREP) screened 720 three and four-year-olds in Henderson and Transylvania Counties for developmental delays, vision, and hearing impairments. Follow-up remediation services were provided to 36 children.

Child Care Resource & Referral Services (CCR&R) provided 60 trainings to child care providers and directors, 310 teachers/directors attended trainings, and 220 technical assistance visits were completed.

Child Care Health Consultant made 56 introductory site visits in Henderson, Rutherford and Polk counties, and held 10 health and safety trainings with 61 unduplicated teachers/directors in attendance.

Early Learning Center (ELC) a lending library for early childhood professionals and parents had 114 members at the end of the fiscal year.

GLO Mobile – camper has been purchased and the renovation is underway. Program delivery is anticipated to start Fall 2022.

FAMILY EDUCATION AND SUPPORT PROGRAMS:

Adolescent Parenting Program (APP) 43 first-time pregnant/parenting teens, including 7 dads, were served in APP. There were 7 APP Graduates and 80% enrolled in post-secondary education or obtained employment.

Parents as Teachers Program (PAT) served 42 families during the fiscal year which included 52 children. 13 Group connections were offered to families and 38 children received developmental screenings.

CFRC Scholarship for Single Parents awarded 11 scholarships, allowing single parents to continue their education at the post-secondary level.

Incredible Years Parenting Program (IY) 3 Incredible Years series were held serving 18 adults and 27 children. 100 % of graduating parents reported a decrease in negative parenting practices.

Circle of Parents® (COP) offered peer-peer leadership and support to 25 parents and 39 children.

Nurturing Parenting (NP) offered three series with 16 parents completing at least 10 out of 12 sessions (+11 parents who started the class but completed fewer than 10 sessions).

Triple P is a parenting toolbox of ideas. We provided 15 families with Triple P individualized consultations on a wide variety of topics.

Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) 11 caregivers received a therapeutic intervention to learn how to use effective relationship and behavior management skills with their child who is presenting challenging behaviors.

Community Response Program (CRP) served 12 parents and 24 children with strength-based case management services and parent education.

Parents Matter! (PM) held 2 virtual series serving 18 parents/caregivers of children ages 9-12.

Full Tum, Dry Bum 259 families with 981 children received diaper and formula assistance, as well as connection to internal and community resources. We distributed 2,530 diaper bundles and 445 formula cans.

Community-Based Doula Project Three people received support from a birth doula and 1 person received postpartum doula support.

Childbirth Education/Breastfeeding Classes- 6 childbirth education classes (5 virtual and 1 in-person) were offered to 19 expectant parents.
